Thirteenth Supplemental Agreement

NETWORK RAIL INFRASTRUCTURE LIMITED

as Network Rail

and

WEST MIDLANDS TRAINS LIMITED

as Train Operator

relating to the Track Access Contract (Passenger Services) dated 15 May 2019

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THIS THIRTEENTH SUPPLEMENTAL AGREEMENT is dated 17th November and made

2022

BETWEEN:

- (1) <u>NETWORK RAIL INFRASTRUCTURE LIMITED</u>, a company registered in England under number 2904587 having its registered office at Network Rail, 1 Eversholt Street, London NW1 2DN ("Network Rail"
- (2) <u>WEST MIDLANDS TRAINS LIMITED</u>, a company registered in England under number 09860466 having its registered office at 2nd Floor St Andrew's House, 18-20 St Andrew Street, London, United Kingdom, EC4A 3AG (the "Train Operator").

WHEREAS:

- (A) The parties entered into a Track Access Contract (Passenger Services) dated 15 May 2019 in a form approved by the Office of Rail and Road pursuant to Section 18 of the R ilways Act 1993 ("the Act") hereafter referred to as the "Contract".
- (B) The parties now propose to enter into this Supplemental Agreement in order to amend the Contract as described herein.

IT IS HEREBY AGREED as follows:

1. **INTERPRETATION**

In this Supplemental Agreement, unless the context otherwise requires:

- (A) words and phrases defined in, and rules of interpretation set out in, the Contract shall have the same meaning and effect when used in this Supplemental Agreement; and
- (B) "Effec ive Date" means the later of the P in ipal Change Date 2022 and the date upon which the ORR issues its approval, pursuant to Section 22 of the Act, of the terms of this Supplemental Agreement.

2. **EFFECTIVE DATE AND TERM**

The amendments to the Contract as set out in this Supplemental Agreement shall have effect from the Effective Date and shall cease to have effect on the Expiry Date or earlier termination of the Contract.

3. AMENDMENTS TO SCHEDULE 5

- 3.1 Table 2.1 (Passenger Train Slots) shall be deleted and replaced with the version set out as Appendix A to this Supplemental Agreement.
- 3.2 Table 2.1 (Additional Passenger Train Slots) shall be deleted and replaced with the version set out as Appendix A to this Supplemental Agreement.
- 3.3 Table 4.1 (Additional Passenger Train Slots) shall be deleted and replaced with the

version set out as Appendix A to this Supplemental Agreement.

4. **GENERAL**

The parties agree that the Contract, as amended by this Supplemental Agreement, shall remain in full force and effect in accordance with its terms, and during the period in which the amendments made by this Supplemental Agreement are to have effect, all references in the Contract to "the contract" or, as the case may be, the "Agreement", "her in", "hereof", "hereunder" and other i ilar expres ions shall, unless the context req ires otherwise, be read and construed as a reference to the Contract as amended by this Supplemental Agreement.

5. THIRD PARTY RIGHTS

No person who is not a party to this Supplemental Agreement shall have any right under the Contracts (Rights of Third Parties) Act 1999 to enforce any term of this Supplemental Agreement.

6. **LAW**

This Supplemental Agreement shall be governed by, construed and given effect to in all respects in accordance with English Law.

7. **COUNTERPARTS**

This Supplemental Agreement may be executed in two counterparts which, taken together, shall constitute one and the same document. Either party may enter into this Supplemental Agreement by signing either of such counterparts.

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IN WITNESS of which the duly authorised representatives of Network Rail and the Train Operator have executed this Supplemental Agreement on the date first above written.

Passenger Train Slots

- 2.1 The Train Operator has Firm Rights to the number of Passenger Train Slots in the Working Timetable in respect of a Service Group as listed against each Service specified in Table 2.1 on the Days and within the Peak and Off-Peak times so listed using any Specified Equipment included in paragraph 5.1(a) that is capable of achieving the Timing Load shown. If the Train Operator makes an Access Proposal, or relies on a Rolled Over Access Proposal, to operate any of the Services specified in Table 2.1 using Specified Equipment that is not capable of achieving the Timing Load shown, then the rights will be treated as Contingent Rights for the purposes of Part D of the Network Code.
- 2.2 In order to provide for the Scheduling of part only of Passenger Train Slots specified in Table 2.1 the Train Operator has:
 - (a) Firm Rights for such a Passenger Train Slot to commence from and/or terminate at [Not used]; and
 - (b) Contingent Rights for such a Passenger Train Slot to commence from and/or terminate at Watford Junction, Tring, Bletchley or Milton Keynes Central (in each case to or from London Euston).
- 2.3 In order to provide through Services the Train Operator has:
 - (a) Firm Rights to combine Passenger Train Slots at Northampton, Birmingham Snow Hill^{13th} and Rugby; and
 - (b) Firm Rights to combine Passenger Train Slots with Train Service Codes 12272323 and 22272000 at ir ingham New Street ('Cross ity' ser ices) 13th and
 - (c) Firm Rights to combine Passenger Train Slots with Train Service Codes 22328000 and 22255000 at Coventry ('Knuckle ser ices") 13th and
 - (d) Contingent Rights to combine Passenger Train Slots at all other locations.
